- 4. Pre-bid meeting shall be held at Ministry of Finance, Singhadurbar at 15th day from the date of publication of notice 11:00 AM.
- 5. Electronic bids must be submitted to the office through PPMO's e-GP system www. bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 12:00PM on 31st day from the date of publication of notice. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
- 6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 2:00PM on 31st day from the date of publication of notice at the office of Ministry of Finance, Singhadurbar, Kathmandu. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of NRs. 3,75,000, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
- 7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid and bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
